



## *Classical Ballet - Grades 1 - 3*

**Amendments to 8th Edition March 2017**

### **Regulation 18**

Teachers must select one of the set classical solos in the syllabus to be demonstrated by each female candidate for each grade. These dances must not be performed in any other grade. Male candidates must perform the set classical solo for each grade.

### **Studio Requirements for Examination Day**

**2** added: security cameras must be covered

### **Dress Requirements**

#### **Girls**

- CSTD pink or black leotard
- Pink ballet tights
- Pink ballet shoes with ribbons (sandalling)
- Hair groomed (in a bun or braid if necessary) and not covering the face and the line of the neck should be visible.
- Each candidate must have an identifying number
- Ribbons or small flowers may be used for hair (pink with a pink leotard, red with a black leotard or yellow to match yellow embroidery)
- Jewellery must not be worn unless required for religious or cultural reasons
- Glasses may be worn
- Light make-up may be worn

In Australia, prior to 2018 female candidates may wear:

- A plain colour or studio leotard
- All candidates in the same examination set must wear the same colour
- Ribbons or small flowers of any colour may for hair

#### **Boys**

- CSTD black shorts
- White short sleeved CSTD leotard
- White socks
- Black or white ballet shoes with elastic
- Neat hair, not covering the face
- Jewellery must not be worn unless required for religious or cultural reasons

In Australia, prior to 2018 male candidates may wear:

- Black or navy bike pants or shorts
- Well fitted white T-shirt or leotard (not singlet)
- white socks
